This was the main theme of the 2010 European Year for Combating Poverty and Social Exclusion and is also a central element of the Europe 2020

strategy. In 2013, in order to mobilize Member States, the EU made recommendations entitled "Investing for chil-

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The benefits of EU



Pandemic makes traveling to EU even difficult for not European countries. Covid makes people stay at home for a year and now everyone wants to travel and the statistics show that the flight to EU is increasing day by day.

There are many problems and challenges that you can come across.



Vaccinated people's documents for going to another country is quite different. There are some vaccines that now is available. 1.CureVac 2.Novavax 3. Sputnik V 4.Sinovac. The Russian Vaccination(Sputnik V) is not allowed in many EU countries but Hungary, Slovenia and Greece are among countries that accept Sputnik V. EU should accept all the vaccines and the traveling can become much easier.

If you are not vaccinated yet, you should have you PSR test with you during your trip. Depending on the country you are visiting, there may be the need to give PSR test and when entering and departing.

There are also a roadmap for vaccinated people which EU is going to public at the end of the summer.

The flights are very fluxed, so be very careful with that. Though

there are many flight to EU but because of the Covid the flight can be rescheduled or can be canceled. It's advisable not to book your tickets too early so you can avoid the chances that your flight can be canceled. In case your flight are 3 or 10 hours you should know that there are no meal served during the flight . But you can buy something to eat, but it is very expensive. So bring something to eat with you during the flight.

The main currency in Europe is Euro. You would better don't compare The value of euro to your countries currency because there is a huge difference, For example in Cyprus I am buying the ice cream with 1.50 euro but in Armenia it is just 50 cents or even less. Just keep in mind that you should have 2 time as much money as you planned in your currency. You should always pay with local currency in euro and it would be preferable to have euro bank card so the process can be easier. If you will pay with dollar, for example, the conversion can be with higher exchange and you will lose money so think about that when planning your trip. So as we speak about money Here is another advice - Avoid ATMs.

When converting money from the foreign ATM, you can be feed for many reasons it can be for example Non-Bank fee. So it would be good to research beforehand and find your countries related bank or TM so-not to lose money.

Those who are from EU has their WIFI everywhere, but as you are going to travel from Non EU country note that there could be situations that you will not have WiFi access or it would be very bad. Before traveling find the apps you need that are working

in offline mode. You can change Google translates to ITranslate translator. You can install maps.me instead of Google maps. And these are not only alternatives you can find in the internet and choose the one that fits you most. Last but not least research the country's traditions and culture of that country, so you will feel free and integrated there.

Furthermore, the next important step is to create a connection between science and business. According to this, the huge circle of cooperation between economics and science should be done in recent years.



Complete the crossword puzzle and find the countries.


