Maybe you don't know, but at the age of 18 you will be forced out of the orphanage. I was alone on the street now.

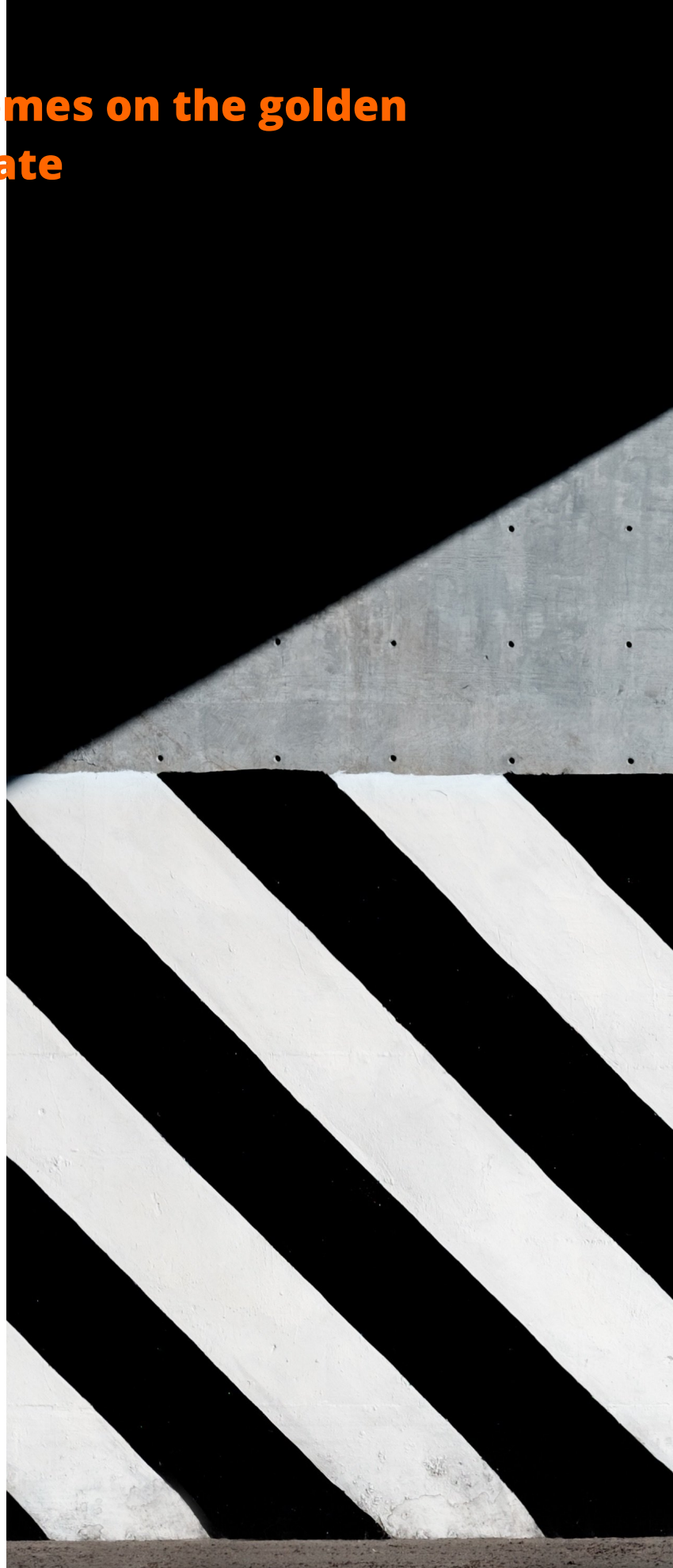
I started living in a ruined house. I had 3-5 friends on the street. I started working in a restaurant with my friends.
